Dear Parent and Camper,

We are looking forward to an exciting weekend at Camp Tapawingo! We are so glad that you are going to be there!

In an effort to ensure a fun and a safe camping experience for all, we would like to briefly discuss the importance of acceptable behavior. We

understand that the campers represent a young age group and we are prepared to offer supervision and guidance in all situations. We are not,

however, equipped to deal with defiant disobedience. Our goal is to provide a safe and fun, Christ-centered experience for everyone.

Our process:

1. Counselor will first talk with camper and give a warning.
2. Counselor will then give appropriate discipline.
3. Camp director will then get involved.
4. If necessary, a call home will be made.

If your camper is unable to maintain appropriate, safe and obedient behavior we will ask that you come to pick up your child at that time.
